## SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS

Mayville High School is run as a charitable trust and as such the Trustees will make awards for excellence. Livesey Scholarships awarded in honour of a previous Headmistress of the school, are available to able pupils in Lower II (Yr 2) and Upper II (Y3) and are worth $50 \%$ of school fees for the remainder of the pupil's Junior School career (until the end of UIII (Yr 6). The awards are made on the basis of an individual interview and assessment coupled with results for pupils who have already taken their Key Stage 1 SATS.

11+ Entry Academic Scholarships of up to $50 \%$ of fees for five years are available for exceptional candidates. These are awarded following an outstanding performance in the assessment procedure.

Creative Arts \& Sports scholarships of up to $50 \%$ of fees for five years are available for pupils with exceptional ability and cover art, drama, music, dance and sport. The award is made as a result of practical assessment and documentary evidence (e.g. a portfolio of work/certificates of achievement/letter of support from a coach etc.) Reasonable performance in the assessment procedure will also be required.

A limited number of Assisted Places are available annually and depend on a combination of academic ability, evidenced in the assessment procedure and parental income. Mayville High School Assisted Places are privately awarded and are not subject to government funding. Details of the scheme may be obtained from the Bursar.

Please note that:

- All our scholarships and assisted places are dependent upon satisfactory work, progress, behaviour and attendance and can be withdrawn at the discretion of the Trustees.
- If you are awarded an assisted place you will be asked to send details of your income each year. Your assisted place allocation may rise or fall in line with any change of circumstances.
- All scholarships, assisted places and awards lie within the sole discretion of the Trustees.
